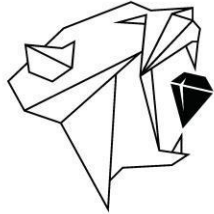
RINGS

Measure your finger at the end of the day. Do not measure your finger if it is cold or hot. Fingers are smaller in the cold and in the morning when you wake up.

Don't forget that your hands are not exactly identical, and that a band you wear on a finger on your left hand will not fit the same on a finger on your right hand. Make sure that the size that you have chosen allows the band to easily slide over the length of the finger on which you will wear the BLACKARAT ring.

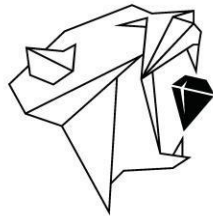
We suggest 2 ways of measuring for your ring size:

- 1) **Measure the circumference of your finger with a measuring tape:** Measure the circumference of your finger in mm. This measurement corresponds to the band size (see the conversion table in the following page in the "Circumference (mm)" column). If you do not have a measuring tape, take a strip of ribbon or string, wrap it around your finger (without pulling too tightly), and measure the resulting length with a ruler.
- 2) **Measure the interior diameter of another ring** that you have that perfectly fits the finger on which you will wear the BLACKARAT ring. This measurement corresponds to the band size (see the conversion table in the following page in the "Diameter (mm)" column). If the measurement is between two diameter measurements, please select the larger of the two.

Then, use the result of your finger's circumference measurement in mm (column on the left: "Your finger's circumference (mm)") or the diameter of your other ring (second column on the left: "Diameter of your ring (mm)"). We have provided you with a conversion table for international sizes for your convenience, so if you indicate the circumference of your finger or the diameter of another ring in mm, we will know the exact ring size we should deliver to you:
